To Parents / Carers of Children in **Year 6**,

Arthog Residential Trip Monday 19th May – Friday 23rd May 2025

Year 6 will have the opportunity to visit Telford & Wrekin Council's Outdoor Residential Centre at **Arthog, North Wales**. At Arthog the children are able to undertake a range of fully supervised outdoor activities, such as hill walking and rock climbing, to canoeing and surfing.

We have been given the date of **Monday 19th May 2025 – Friday 23rd May 2025**.

The cost of the trip is **£339.00** per student which includes meals, the use of specialist equipment and insurance **plus £23.75** towards the transport.

As the Outdoor Centre at Arthog is very popular, we have only managed to secure places for **40 children**. If you are interested in your child taking part in the excursion, could you **please complete and return the Arthog Consent Form to the school office and pay £32.75 deposit on ParentPay by 31st October 2024**. Deposits are **non-refundable**, other than for withdrawal due to a pupil leaving the school or GP proof of illness being provided.

The Arthog visit will be available to book on ParentPay from Tuesday 1st October. Places will be allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis.

Cancellation fees

Payment

The full price of the visit is £362.75. This can be paid in instalments or in full by **1st April 2025**.

We recognise this is such a large expenditure, we will be offering parents/carers the option to pay in instalments and have devised a *recommended* payment plan to help spread the cost.



Recommended payment plan

| Instalment | Suggested Amount | Date |

| Instalment ONE | £55.00 | 1st November 2024 |

| Instalment FOUR | £55.00 | 1st February 2025 |
| Instalment FIVE | £55.00 | 1st March 2025 |
| Instalment SIX | £55.00 | Please ensure any balance outstanding is paid by 1st April 2024 |

In addition to the cost of the visit, we are offering you the opportunity to **purchase an Arthog hoodie** for your child's residential trip and have negotiated a special arrangement with Bakers & Son in Wellington.

Along with other schools we have decided on a uniform approach so that all Randlay children will wear the same **BLACK hoodie with their own initials printed on the front and Arthog 25 on the back**. This is not compulsory and please do not feel obliged to purchase a hoodie if you do not wish too.

The cost of the hoodie is £15.00 for child's size and £18.50 for an adult's size.

To purchase a hoodie you have three options: -

You can order a hoodie direct from Bakers AFTER Monday 30th September 2024. The deadline date for ordering a hoodie is **Friday 5th April 2025**. Bakers will deliver all prepaid hoodies to the school before the visit.

If you would like your child to experience this residential visit, please complete the attached consent form and information required on ParentPay as soon as possible. I hope you are able to allow your child to go on this educational experience. If you consent for your child to attend there will be a parents/carers meeting to discuss the arrangements.

Please note that the Arthog residential visit involves demanding physical activity and therefore if any pupil has any pre-existing medical conditions, please ensure you include this information on the consent form. It is your responsibility to inform us of any changes between now and the time of the visit.
