Dear Parents / Carers of Children in **Year 2, Base 8 and Base 9**,

Coalbrookdale Residential Visit Thursday 26th June to Friday 27th June 2025

As you may have seen on the school website, our annual one-night residential visit for the children in **year 2** has been arranged for **Thursday 26th to Friday 27th June**. We have booked Coalbrookdale Youth Hostel and have lined up a range of exciting activities over the two days.

Spaces are limited and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

The itinerary is as follows: -

Thursday 26th June 2025

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| 9.30am | We will leave school and travel by coach to Coalbrookdale Youth Hostel to drop off our luggage. We will then enjoy a full day of outdoor activities, including den building and river stream dipping with Arthog Outreach before returning to the Youth Hostel. |
| 5.30pm | A two course meal will be served (children will be given the opportunity to make their meal choices before we go), followed by games. |
| 9.00pm | Evening drink and bedtime. |

The visit will include accommodation, meals, transport, museum entrance and workshop, Arthog Outreach activities and insurance.

Payment options - The cost of the visit will be £114.00.



In order to secure a place for your child we will require a minimum **£24.00 deposit, paid via ParentPay, by Friday 4th April.**

This deposit is **non-refundable** other than for withdrawal due to a pupil leaving the school or GP proof of illness to be provided. You may wish to pay for the trip in full or use the suggested instalment option below.
