The **coach will depart from school promptly at 9am**, so please make sure children arrive on time. Unfortunately, due to the schedule, we will be unable to wait for any late arrivals. We aim to **return to school by 3:15pm**, in time for the usual end-of-day arrangements.

The cost of the visit will be **£19.75** which goes towards the entrance fee, workshop and transport. **The deadline for giving consent and payment is Monday 31st March**. Please be aware should your child not attend the trip for any reason, we cannot guarantee a refund.

All children will require a **packed lunch** and **drink/s** (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks). Please ensure you send enough to drink as there will be no access to refill bottles/purchase more on the day. **If your child is entitled to Free School Meals** and you would like school to provide your child with a school packed lunch, can you please **indicate on ParentPay by Monday 31st March, if they would like a HAM or CHEESE sandwich**. Alternatively, they may prefer to bring their own.

Please provide your child with a **small lightweight backpack or carrier bag which is suitable for carrying their lunch and drink/s in on the day**.



Children will need to come to school in their **full school uniform** including their red school jumper/cardigan, a waterproof coat and black school shoes.

Children will not require any spending money.

If your child requires any medication on the day of the visit, including travel sickness tablets, this will need to be taken with them and given to their class teacher on the morning of the visit along with a medication form which you can collect from the school office.

If your child needs an **inhaler or EpiPen**, please ensure this is taken with them on the day.
