Dear Parents/Carers of children in **Year 6**,

On **Wednesday 17th December** we are taking our Key Stage Two children to **Telford Theatre** to see a performance of *Cinderella*.

Theatre trips offer children an exciting and immersive learning experience. Attending a live performance helps to develop their **listening and comprehension skills**, sparks their **imagination and creativity**, and provides a deeper understanding of **storytelling, character, and stagecraft**. It also enhances their confidence and cultural awareness, giving them valuable experiences that support the curriculum in English, drama, and the arts. We strongly encourage all children to attend and enjoy this enriching opportunity.

**This trip is FREE** for all **Year 6 children**, thanks to the generous support of **Hollinswood and Randlay Parish Council**, who are kindly funding the trip.

Telford Theatre have asked us to confirm the final numbers by Monday 6<sup>th</sup> October at the latest. **Therefore, to secure your child's place can you please confirm, via ParentPay, if your child WILL be attending the theatre trip no later than Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> October.**

We will be walking to and from the International Centre, **leaving school promptly at 12.30pm** for a 1.30pm performance. The children are expected to **return to school at approximately 4.00pm**.

When we return to school, children will go straight into the building and be dismissed directly from their class bases. Please **do not collect your child until they have been registered with their teacher** in their base. For safeguarding reasons, parents and carers should not wait on the playground and will only be allowed back in once all children are safely in their bases.



**For children in Year 5 and Year 6, please note that due to the later finish time, we will require your consent if you wish for your child to walk home independently. Otherwise, we will assume that they will be collected.**

**All children attending the theatre trip will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink** (please note: no fizzy drinks or glass bottles). If your child is entitled to **Free School Meals (FSM)** and you would like school to provide a packed lunch with either a cheese or ham sandwich, please indicate this via ParentPay. Alternatively, your child may prefer to bring their own packed lunch from home. We recommend that lunches are sent in a disposable bag that can be thrown away after eating, and lunch boxes should be left at home due to the quick turnaround when we return to school.

**Children will eat their lunch at school before leaving for the theatre and are welcome to bring a small packet of sweets/biscuit to enjoy during the performance.** Please **DO NOT** send any money as there will be no other concessions available for purchase on the day.

If your child requires medication on the day of the visit, including inhalers or an EpiPen, this will need to be taken with them and given to their class teacher on the morning of the visit. Please ensure you have completed a medical form prior to the visit taking place.
