Dear Parents and Carers,

## Year 6 Arthog Visit Monday 9th February – Friday 13th February 2026

With the Year 6 visit to Arthog fast approaching, I am writing to confirm a few important details regarding departure day, as discussed at the meeting on Thursday 8th January.

### Packed Lunch and Water Bottle for Day One

Children will require a home packed lunch and a water bottle for the first day. This should be in a NAMED disposable bag and kept separate from their luggage. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals and you have ordered a school packed lunch, this will be provided on Monday morning.

### Medical

If your child has any medical needs that we are not already aware of, please inform the school office as soon as possible. If medication is required during the visit, please complete a medical form, which is available from the school office and will also be available in the school hall on the morning of departure. Please hand the completed form to Mrs Robertson on the morning of the visit, along with the medication in a clearly named plastic box.

### Packing Information

We recommend that your child helps with packing for the visit so they can identify their belongings, which will also help them when packing their own bag for the return journey. Please ensure all items are clearly labelled to help us make sure everything is returned to the correct person.

Due to the weather at this time of year, children should bring warm layers, including gloves and a hat. Please refer to the attached kit list for more details on what to bring.

Children will also need to bring a bottom sheet, duvet cover, and pillowcase.

Mobile phones, electronic devices (including gaming and music devices), jewellery, and special clothes should be left at home.



## Spending Money

We suggest a maximum of **£10.00** as pocket money. Children will be responsible for their own money, which should be sent in a named purse or wallet. **Arthog has requested that money is provided in coins (£2, £1, 50p, 20p) rather than notes.**

## Arrival and Departure Information

The coach will depart school at 9.15am on Monday 9th February. Children should arrive at school for 8.35am, bringing their named luggage into the school hall via the double blue doors, where they will wait for registration.

On Friday 13th February, we will depart from Arthog at approximately midday and aim to arrive back at school in time for the usual end-of-day pick-up at 3.15 pm. Should there be any delays, we will keep you updated via text message.

We will do our best to upload photos on the Randlay Facebook page throughout the week; however, please be aware that the Arthog Centre has very limited internet access. While we cannot guarantee that every child will appear in a photo, the updates will give you a flavour of the activities taking place.
