Dear Parents/Carers of children in **Year 3 and Year 4**,

Bishops Wood Field Trip

We have arranged an educational visit to Bishops Wood Field Studies Centre as part of our history topic on the Romans, providing children with a hands-on and immersive learning experience. The visit will take place over two days:

- **Base 3** will attend on **Tuesday 10th March**
- **Base 10 and Base 11** will attend on **Wednesday 11th March**

During the visit, pupils will take part in a range of hands-on activities including exploring the life of a Roman soldier, learning about Roman roads and engineering, using simple surveying tools, and participating in drama-based activities linked to Roman culture. This experience brings classroom learning to life, deepens pupils understanding of the Romans' impact on Britain, and supports the Key Stage 2 history curriculum in an engaging and memorable way, while helping to develop teamwork, confidence and communication skills.

We will travel by coach, leaving school at **9:00am** and returning at approximately **3:40pm**.

When we return to school, children will go straight into the building and be dismissed from the following doors:

- **Base 3** – Base 3 door (Tuesday 10th March)
- **Base 10** – School Reception (Wednesday 11th March)
- **Base 11** – School carpark doors, between B7 and B8 (Wednesday 11th March)

Please do not collect your child until they have been registered with their teacher in school.

The cost of the visit will be **£21.90** which goes towards the cost of the entrance fee and transport.

This payment can be made in two installments or paid in full via ParentPay by Monday 2nd March. Please be aware should your child not attend the trip for any reason we cannot guarantee a refund.



Children will need a packed lunch and a drink (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks) which they will eat during the visit. **If your child is entitled to a Free School Meal** and you would like school to provide your child with a school packed lunch, can you please indicate on ParentPay if they would like a **HAM or CHEESE sandwich by Monday 2nd March** at the latest. Alternatively, they may prefer to bring their own.

Please ensure children come to school dressed in suitable outdoor clothing, such as wellies or old shoes, warm clothes (layers are recommended, for example a long-sleeved T-shirt and a jumper, with leggings and/or joggers), and a waterproof coat in case of wet weather.

Please provide your child with a small lightweight backpack or carrier bag which is suitable for carrying their lunch and drink/s in on the day.

If your child requires any medication, including travel sickness tablets, please ensure this is taken with them by handing this to their class teacher and completing a medication form, which you can collect from the school office before the visit.

If you have any questions regarding the trip, please do not hesitate to contact the school office. Thank you for your continued support in helping us provide these valuable learning experiences for the children.
