## Visit to Weston Park

As part of our topic this term, we have arranged an exciting educational visit to **Weston Park**. **Year 1 and Year 2 will attend on separate dates** (see below). If your child is in a mixed-age class, they will go on the appropriate day for their year group.

- **Year 1:** Friday 5<sup>th</sup> June
- **Year 2:** Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June

Children will have the opportunity to explore the beautiful grounds at Weston Park while learning about plants, wildlife, and different habitats. As they take part in outdoor activities, the children will develop their observation and communication skills, deepen their understanding of the natural environment, and experience learning beyond the classroom. The visit will also include a trip through the maze, roasting marshmallows around the campfire, and a ride on the miniature train, making it a fun and memorable day.

The coaches will **depart from school at 9.30am** and are expected to return to school at approximately 3pm, so the end-of-day arrangements will be as normal.

**The total cost of the visit is £21.40**, which covers both the entrance fee and transport costs. If you would like your child to attend the visit, please confirm their place and make the full payment by **Friday 29th May** at the latest.

**Children will need to bring a packed lunch and drink/s to have during the visit.** If you would like school to provide your child with a packed lunch, please select either a cheese or ham sandwich option on ParentPay. **However, please note that school packed lunch orders must be placed by Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May, at the latest, to allow the school cook time to place an order.**

Children should wear **full school uniform**, including their red school sweatshirt, and **weather-appropriate footwear**. Please ensure they also bring a **waterproof coat** in case of rain.



If your child needs medication on the day (including travel sickness tablets), please ensure this is given to the class teacher on the morning of the visit, along with a medication form which can be collected from the school office.

We are looking forward to a wonderful day of learning and exploration.
