Dear Parents / Carers of children in **Year 6**

Crucial Crew – Year 6

I am pleased to inform you that the children in **Year 6** have been invited to participate in the **Crucial Crew** scheme taking place next week on **Wednesday 1st July**. This scheme, which is organised by Telford & Wrekin Council, is targeted at 10–11 year old children aiming to equip them with essential life skills as they transition to secondary school. The scheme covers a range of topics, including:

- avoiding becoming victims of crime
- coping with dangerous situations
- learning social responsibility
- understanding the role of the Police

This takes place during the school day at **Telford College**. The children will be transported to and from the event by coach and will leave school at approximately **9.15am** and return for **2.45pm**. Therefore, arrangements for the end of the school day will be as normal.

Children will require a packed lunch and adequate drinks for throughout the day (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please). If your child is entitled to a Free School Meal and you would like school to provide your child with a school packed lunch, can you please indicate if they would like a HAM or CHEESE sandwich **by 9am on Friday 26th June AT THE LATEST using the following link**. Please provide your child with a **small lightweight backpack or carrier bag which is suitable for carrying their lunch and drink/s in on the day**.

What to wear

Children should come to school wearing their **school PE uniform** and **black trainers**. Children will also need to wear their **red Randlay sweatshirt/cardigan**.

PE Wear – please ensure your child is wearing the correct PE Uniform

- Red logo PE t-shirt (supplied by Bakers) or a plain red t-shirt (football tops are not permitted)
- Black PE shorts and/or black jogging bottoms
- Black logo PE hoodie (supplied by Bakers) or a plain black sweatshirt / hoodie.



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If your child arrives in non-uniform, school will provide them with something more suitable for the visit as the organisers have stated that all children **MUST** be in school uniform.

Children should bring a waterproof coat for inclement weather and will need a labelled sunhat to protect them from the sun should it be a hot day. Please ensure high factor suncream is applied before school. You are welcome to send a bottle of suncream, clearly labelled with your child's name, so that your child can reapply themselves should they need to.

Photography Consent

We have been advised that a photographer will be present during the event. If you **DO NOT** consent to your child being photographed, please contact the school office by **Friday 26th June**.

Medication

Any medication that your child is required to take will need to be handed to your child's class teacher on the morning of the trip and a medical form will need to be completed (inc any travel sickness tablets).

We will assume that you are happy for your child to take part in the visit unless you contact the school office by Friday 26th June to let us know otherwise.
