Please ensure your child brings their change of clothes to school in a named carrier bag by Friday, 10th July at the latest. We ask that you **do not** send any dressing-up clothes, as the focus is on neat and appropriate attire for the assembly

If you are bringing younger siblings, they **MUST** be supervised at ALL times by a parent or carer.
